## Word Alive 8<sup>th</sup> February

Once again international initiatives have invited us not to forget the death camps of WWII. Christians can struggle, but usually put up a valiant show, explaining evil, it's source and final defeat. Actually we should be concerned not to stop there. Whatever evil is, when we see, even experience something we would call evil, it horrifies us - or should do. There seem to be so many perpetrators of evil too - religion, science, politicians, megalomaniacs even that person down the road. And let's not forget nature with its unprovoked disasters, diseases and its evolutionary mechanism picking on you for no seeming purpose.

A key question given to Christians, the truth may be that we do struggle to come to terms with evil. But we must and the Bible invites us to engage with the problem of evil not just in an academic way but with all our feelings too. There is much in Scripture that consists of ranting against evil people and events.

During the evening we aim to air the problem of evil and help each other to face the questions around evil and to walk more closely to Christ despite evil.
