Welcome to a new year with **Word Alive**, the first of which is this Sunday, 7:30 p.m. at our place.

I am aware that one home group might be looking at heaven and hell, so I won't double up on what they might cover. But we will be looking at a topic that relates to that - Life After Death. It is one topic that concerns everyone, and is so difficult for us to face that many will not talk about it, or palm it off with a quick word about what they say will happen. But for now, what happens straight after death is a mystery which we can't know in the same way we know everything else.

We will delve into the Bible for answers. We will also look at what alternatives other people think. Many think that Christianity is all about going to heaven when you die, but it is popular now to think we cease to exist after death, when our matter crumbles away to dust. How, then, do we explain our faith to such people? And what do you believe will happen next after you take your last breath...?
