## Word Alive

Last time we looked at the Apostle Paul – his Jewish background, conversion and beliefs. Much of the New Testament comes from Paul and some sticky issues arise. What makes us human? Are we simply a soul locked in a body? How do we deal with a Christian who keeps on sinning? What happened to the promises to Israel in the Old Testament? And those bits about women. Keep quiet in church? Really?

We can put forward our own views but will try to gain more as we listen to each other and the views of other Christians. And women may speak.

### *From the minister...*

We have just celebrated Pentecost, which marks the coming of the Holy Spirit in power and the birth of the church. As the church grew things just got better. Until others noticed. It was the religious leaders, implicated in the crucifixion of Jesus, who got jealous of the success of the Jesus movement and so kicked off a season of persecution. And it continues to this day.

We are pleased to be informed by the work of Open Doors, who work to raise the issue of persecuted Christians throughout the world. They campaign at the Houses of Parliament to inform MPs, encourage changes in legislation and push for pressure to be put on foreign countries to protect Christians. We stand with them.

And we stand with the persecuted. Having someone mock your faith is not really persecution. It is opposition, yes, and not to be trivialised. But we stand with those whose livelihood, security and even lives are at stake. Even if it is simply in our prayers that we support them, let us do so. Our prayers might lead us to further action.
