The end of Covid restrictions is in sight – sort of. At our Church Members' Meeting on Tuesday, we reminded one another that we still need to care for everyone's welfare and that self-imposed precautions of some sort are best maintained.

From Sunday 25th, the limit of numbers using the hall has been increased to 60, though over the Summer this should not cause problems for us. Singing indoors will be allowed.

Here's some things we can recommend that we keep to for the time being...

- Masks not mandatory but recommended
- Use hand sanitiser on the way in 
- There will be some areas in the hall with more distance between seats for those who are more comfortable with greater spacing
- Avoiding touching, hugging unless both people say it is OK 
- Don't get too close to one another
- Communion will be served and received hygienically
- Avoid unguarded coughing

1. Go onto the internet and type kcbchurch.org.uk
