A Christian grows when he prays. When you were a baby, you had to learn to walk. You learn to pray in the same way. God doesn't expect your words to be perfect. When I heard my son Franklin say “Da-da” for the first time, the words were more beautiful than any ever said by Churchill. I would have been a little worried, however, if he had still been saying “Da-da” when he was twelve years old.

Some people think they have to be emotionally moved to pray before the prayer is really meaningful. The person who waits to pray until he feels like it will never pray.

The bible says you are to *“pray without ceasing”* 1

Thess.5:17 this means we can be in a spirit of prayer in the car, walking down the street...wherever you may be.
