## *From the Pastor...*

Churches are not allowed to engage in social action in France, so we were informed by John Wilson on Sunday. Can you imagine the same rule for the UK? Much of our society would be affected and many would miss out. We do have a restriction in that many public funded grants to not give out to church groups that promote faith in any way. It has to be written out of all they do in the area of social action they receive funds for.

What the French and British authorities don't grasp is that when practised correctly, our faith works. It works out in social action. It hardly needs saying that that is regardless of the gender, religion, ethnicity etc. of those in need. We have the parable of the Good Samaritan to instruct us in that. Faith works. It works first to draw us to love the Lord with all we have got, then to love the people around us in the way we love ourselves.

KCBC as a church community, when functioning rightly, looks both upwards to the Lord and also outwards to those around us. We do that at an individual level and as a church. So we value such groups as KILTS and Messy Church and we look to further involvement in things like the Kingsteignton garden project. And we will keep looking out. We will because our faith works and when it does it is amazing.
