from Can you drink the cup? By Henri Nouwen

Community is like a large mosaic. Each little piece seems so insignificant. One piece is bright red, another cold blue or dull green; another warm purple, another sharp yellow, another shining gold.

Some look precious, others ordinary; some look valuable, others worthless;

Some look gaudy, others delicate.

As individual stones, we can do little with them and judge their beauty and value.

When however, all these stones are brought together in one big mosaic, portraying the face of Christ, who would question the importance of any of them? If one of them even the least spectacular one, is missing, the face is incomplete.
