## *From David*

Following on from our survey of your views on returning to the hall, on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup>, our Sunday worship will be live at the Community Hall. It will be a hybrid of live at the hall, live on Zoom or recorded. Here are your choices in joining:

### Live at the hall

- You will be able to sit in family groups or pre-existing bubbles.
- Content will either be live from the front or projected on the screen and (hopefully) we will be able to see people on Zoom.
- At the end, weather permitting, there will be an opportunity to go outside and be led in singing. Yes, we will be able to SING TOGETHER again after all this time. You may also chat in the car park.
- The children and young people's workers will let you know what arrangements are planned. If they meet, they will either be in the Rydon Room or the MHS.

- Help! Yes, we will need help, so please let me or Sue know if you can help with any of the teams in 'We need helpers' below.
- You will need to book beforehand with Sue by email or phone, sign in or use the hall QR code, wear a mask at all times indoors, sanitise your hands, follow seating instructions, and only exit when shown. If you turn up without booking, you will be allowed in if there are spare places. 30 is the limit. Helps us to book.
- Hall and disabled toilets will be open, I will have had a lateral flow Covid test beforehand, the hall will have been sanitised and there will be a good air flow.

### **Live on Zoom**

- Zoom will run as before, starting at 10:00 a.m. and there will be opportunity for Chat Rooms. There will be one camera operating to bring the live service to Zoom. The Zoom screen will (we hope) be projected into the hall.
- The sign up details for Zoom remain the same.
- The outdoor singing will not appear on Zoom.

### **Recorded**

- The recorded service will be available as before.

### **So here we go...**

It will take us a while to adjust to these changes, and we anticipate a slow but steady transition. A few extra things...

- Come back to the hall only when you are ready and feel safe.
- Please respect those who are attending but need to take extra care because they can't (yet) have a vaccination. Keep a reasonable distance when talking and avoid contact like shaking hands or hugging, except with permission.
- We will try to keep you as safe as possible. Look out for ways for us to improve.
- Encourage the TechTeam and musicians. This is quite a challenge.

To make this possible, we need help. Some of you have already indicated your willingness to help. For the 23<sup>rd</sup>, then the 30<sup>th</sup>, can you...

- Be part of the Set-Up Team on the 23<sup>rd</sup> or the 30<sup>th</sup>?

A full set of clear instructions are provided for each team.
