A Message from cr2ee's Trustees

We are very grateful to you and all our supporters for the wonderful support in so many ways for the work of cr2ee in Moldova and Ukraine. The work cr2ee is able to do is only because of the donations of money, aid, sorting and loading of aid, and many other helps we receive. THANK YOU.

We have prepared a **Review of 2022**, which outlines our aims, and our activities last year. A copy is shown below.

The latest truck has delivered 12 tonnes of humanitarian aid to Ukraine including 6 electricity generators, many boxes of dried food, toiletries and medical items. This was possible only because of the wonderful work of volunteers to clean up and tidy the store after a substantial vandalism event and damage to some of the goods. Various others helped in other ways including loading the truck. We want to say a big THANK YOU.

Christian Response to Eastern Europe REVIEW OF 2022

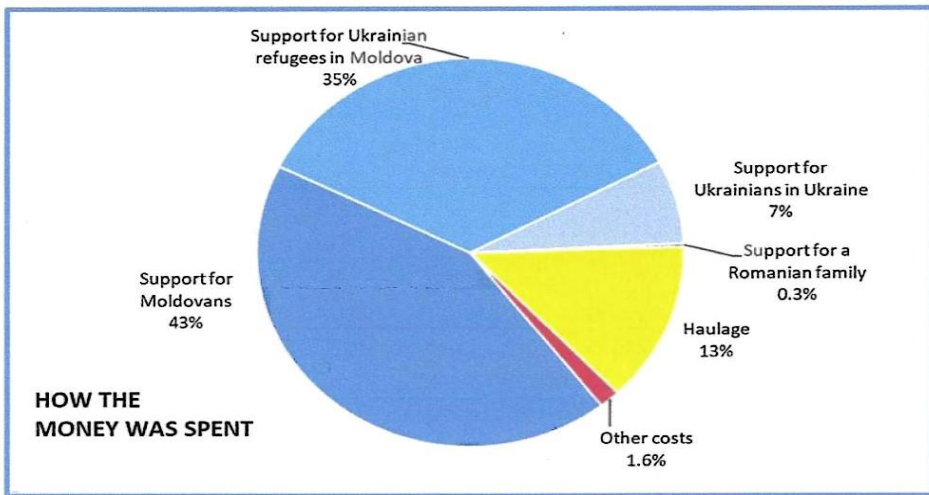


cr2ee's MISSION is to provide relief to disadvantaged and vulnerable people living in Eastern Europe through the support received from individuals and organisations in the UK.

It is a **VOLUNTARY ORGANISATION**. We have no staff, no-one receives any pay and everyone gives their time freely. As a result, our administration costs (for insurance, audit, postage and banking charges etc.) were only 1½% of total expenditure.

In 2022 we achieved more than ever before!

- **MOLDOVA.** We sent £100,000 to Moldova, via trusted partners, to support about 200 families, 4 soup kitchens and churches working with the poor. We sent 2 lorries to Moldova containing excellent quality clothing, over 5000 Christmas shoeboxes and family boxes, and other humanitarian aid.
- **UKRAINE.** There was an amazing response to the Ukraine Appeal we set up, because of the war, to help Ukrainian refugees in Moldova and displaced people in Ukraine. We sent £98,000 and 5 lorries containing humanitarian aid.
- **HELPERS.** All this was achieved because of the incredible work by our volunteers and supporters to deliver, sort and load aid. In total we sent 89 tonnes of aid in the 7 lorry loads. A massive thank you to everyone!
- **PUBLICITY.** We gave talks to interested groups, sent out newsletters and held prayer support meetings to help keep supporters updated on cr2ee's activities. News was also posted on our FaceBook page and our website.
- **TRUSTEES.** Graham Carey (Chairman), Hugh Scudder (Charity Director) and Richard Critchley (Secretary and Treasurer) met on 6 occasions to manage cr2ee's finances and operation.
