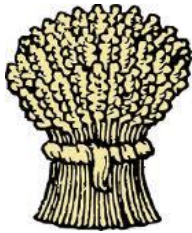

meals for those in hostels.

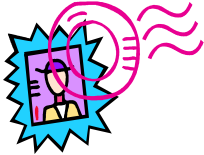
