On 20th June, we loaded our fourth lorry in four months. This is a fantastic achievement and we are very grateful to all our volunteers and supporters

This lorry is filled with much need humanitarian aid to help the victims of war in Ukraine, many of whom lost everything following the breach of the dam in Kherson. We now urgently need donations of very good quality clothing and bedding, medical supplies - especially pain killers and dressings, non-perishable food, hygiene items and toiletries, etc. and of course, sufficient funds for the next lorry.
