LATEST UPDATE

After only one week our truck arrived in central Ukraine and has been successfully unloaded and ready for distribution.

In addition to medical and other humanitarian aid we had a lot of valuable new items, six electric generators, over one hundred solar lanterns, four 100 watt solar panels to charge the six Ecoflow Portable Power Stations, over 100 Solar Power banks and so much more. These alone would be valued at over £15,000. Add to this the many tonnes of new and very good quality clothing, bedding, food and medical supplies and you will understand how grateful they are in war-torn Ukraine.

We have amazing supporters and volunteers, thank you all.
