The property next to Lidl's that has been vacant for years is now covered in scaffolding. It is being refurbished by a Christian organisation called Chapter 1 who oversee The Torbay PSL project (and the Leonard Stokes Centre). They provide homes for people from all sectors of the community, specialising in providing accommodation for people who have difficulty in finding somewhere to live. This includes those who have lost homes because of unemployment, debt problems, young people coming out of care, people fleeing from domestic abuse and those with mental health problems.

This week, David met with people from this group and it was good to introduce this Christian organisation to the churches in the area. They are keen to work with us as a point of contact to help integrate their tenants into the community where that is helpful. There are some leaflets on the table for further information.
