The late Billy Graham once said, “A cheque book is a theological document, it will tell you who and what you worship.” Now, not everyone uses a cheque book in these days of online banking and quick pay apps, but the point is still well made. As a church we are reliant on the giving of our congregation and the more we give, the more the government returns to us via Gift Aid. Gift Aid allows us to reclaim 25p for every £1 taxpayers give to the church, either directly through the banking system or via our offertory giving, and this year we were able to claim back the sizeable amount of £10556. However, our costs are rising each year and if you have not reviewed your giving for some time, I would encourage you to do so as a good spiritual exercise.
