**Musungwa House Group is continuing a meditation on the Apostles' Creed.**

This week we are looking at "I believe in Jesus Christ ... .. who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, ...", again!

In being born, Jesus assumed the nature of humanity. In doing so, He made it possible for God to dwell with man in our own consciousness, and enabled man to rise into communion with God.

“... an affirmation of Jesus’s manhood is an assertion that He was born out of, and into, humanity in the same sense every man is; that He was a son of Abraham, just as every man participates in his own race or nation or culture; and more important, that He was a son of Adam, as all men are, regardless of what their culture, nation or race may be. ...” *John Knox*

What marks Jesus Christ as a man?

- 1) The experience of growth, or development - Luke 2:48-52; 22:28; Heb 2:10; 2:17; 5:8.
- 2) Death – Phil 2:8; Acts 2:23.
- 3) Self-consciousness – “Unless He had a human consciousness, He was not a man” *John Knox*.
- 4) Sin – Could Jesus have sinned? Hebrews 5:7-10; Mark 10:18.

Is it important for us as humans that Jesus Christ was born? Why?

What examples of His humanity are shown in the scriptures?

Is the humanity of Jesus Christ all that there is ... or is there something more?

*D M Baillie* says: “Whatever Jesus was or did, in His life, in His preaching, in His cross and passion, in His resurrection and ascension and exaltation, it is really God that did it in Jesus: that is how the New Testament speaks.”
