## **Give thanks to the Lord for He is good His love endures forever: Psalm 118**

We rarely talk about financial matters but it is important every now and then that we do stop and reflect on this aspect of our church life. The church has an annual budget of just over £60,000 which covers all aspects of the life, work and ministry of KCBC. Of course, as in all walks of life, our costs continue to rise and so our giving needs to respond accordingly. Remember, we are entirely self-funded and so it is the responsibility of us all to give regularly as we are able (either through the banking system or the offertory bag), and to periodically review the level of our giving. The good news is that if you are a tax payer we can reclaim 25p for every £1 you give from the government, and we can also claim the same for our offertory giving up to a £1250 ceiling. For the 2014/15 tax year, we have reclaimed £9854.75, for which we are very grateful to God! If you would like to know more about how to give regularly to the church through the banking system, if you would like to set up a gift aid declaration or if you have any other financial queries please do contact me and I'd be happy to help.
