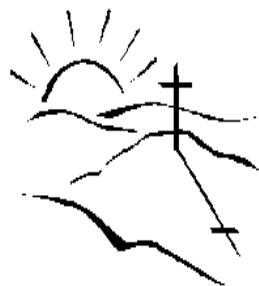
## Befriending at Coombeswood Residential Home
