## Romans – verses from our recent study



1:16 I am not ashamed of the gospel because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes.

1:17 For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last.

3:10 There is no-one righteous, not even one.

3:24 All are justified freely by His grace through the redemption that came through Christ Jesus.

3:25 God presented Jesus as a sacrifice of atonement, through faith in his blood.

4:25 Jesus our Lord was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification.

5:8 While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

6:2 The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Jesus Christ our Lord.

7:25,25 Who will rescue me from this body of death? Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord!

8:1 There is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

8:37 In all things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.

9:15 For God says to Moses “I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion.”

12:1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God’s mercy to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God – this is your spiritual act of worship.
