The Winter Olympics in Sochi have presented Russian Christians with an opportunity to spread God's word in some unique and inviting ways.

More than gold medals will be given out at the 2014 Winter Olympics held in Sochi, Russia. BMS World Mission partner organisation, Russian Ministries, will be distributing inspirational materials in a variety of forms, to share the gospel with spectators. To help, BMS is providing an £8,000 grant from the Mission Innovation Fund (MIF) that is going towards the cost of printing some of the magazines and booklets. For the next two weeks, over 500 evangelical churches in 11 major cities will be inviting the community to join them as the country celebrates this historic pastime with the world.
