CHURCH MEMBERS MEETING (AGM)

Tuesday 3rd February at 7:30pm
in the Mary Hall Suite

This Tuesday evening the membership meets for the quarterly church meeting which is also our AGM.

It's always an important meeting and gives the leadership team a chance to share our thoughts with the members as well as looking to them to help guide us in current and future decisions we make on behalf of the whole church.

Rose Millard (our moderator) will be joining us and chairing the meeting and will also present some initial guidance as we start to consider the pastoral vacancy process and the first steps we need to take as a church in preparation for that.

Church Social List

Back at the end of last year, I said that I would be starting the verification of all our contact data and producing the latest version of the church social list. Family events and the festivities overtook me, so I am only now ready to start that process.

Until recently your data was managed on a spreadsheet on the secretary's laptop which was a bit archaic and the data in there was only available to me.

The leadership agreed that we should move our contact data to a new tool called "Churchsuite".

So, what is Churchsuite ?

Churchsuite is an online tool used by many hundreds of UK churches and is fully secure and compliant with the UK data protection regulations. I will strictly manage access to the tool and at the moment its restricted to just the leadership team.

It has a great many functions to manage all things 'church' but we will be using it in its simplest form to manage just your contact details.

I will in the next couple of days set the tool up to email you all a link into Churchsuite to verify your personal details.

For most of us it's a simple check that the data is correct and clicking a submit button. However, I am aware that we aren't all 'computer wizards' and I'll be on hand to help, and also to do the verification on behalf of those who don't have a computer or smart phone.

Update and Prayer requests January 2026

MOLDOVA

Life in Moldova is especially tough during the winter months with daytime temperatures around freezing and night times well below that. Wood is still the main source of heating, but many cannot afford to buy it so our partner churches continue to chop and provide firewood wherever they can.

Over 6000 shoe boxes were delivered to Moldova (and Ukraine) before Christmas. More arrived at the collection point after the deadline and these were sent on the January Aid Lorry that left on the 17th. These shoe boxes make such a difference and were so appreciated by all who received them. cr2ee has been a long-time supporter of a child called Andrea. Preparatory work has started on converting a storage room at her school into a suitable classroom for her and other children with disabilities and special educational needs.

Staff at Vranich House in Exeter are offering their expertise on how to make this new facility work for those who are desperately in need of specialist support.

Please pray:

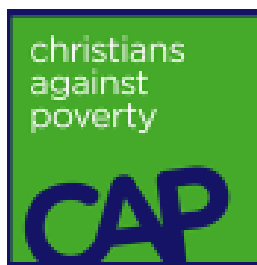
- ▶ For everyone involved in donating, collecting, packing, delivering and distributing aid to the people of Moldova.

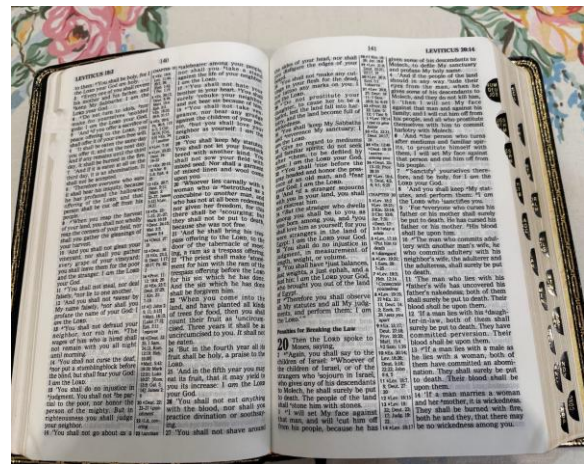
