### *Leadership Update*

Our Vision Day on **26 September** will be a significant opportunity for everyone to contribute to discerning God's vision for the future of KCBC and the calling of our next Minister.

As we continue this important journey together, please join us in praying for unity, wisdom, and the clear guidance of the Holy Spirit. We look forward with excitement and anticipation to sharing this process with the whole congregation as we seek God's purposes for our church.

Reflecting on the Parable of the Ten Virgins, let us also encourage one another to be spiritually ready for the arrival of our future Minister by keeping our lamps filled with the oil of the Holy Spirit and continuing to feed daily on God's living Word, through which He provides our daily bread.

It presents a calm, evidence-based overview of how the climate and nature crisis is affecting everyday life in Britain - and what the science says about risks and responses. More information in link:

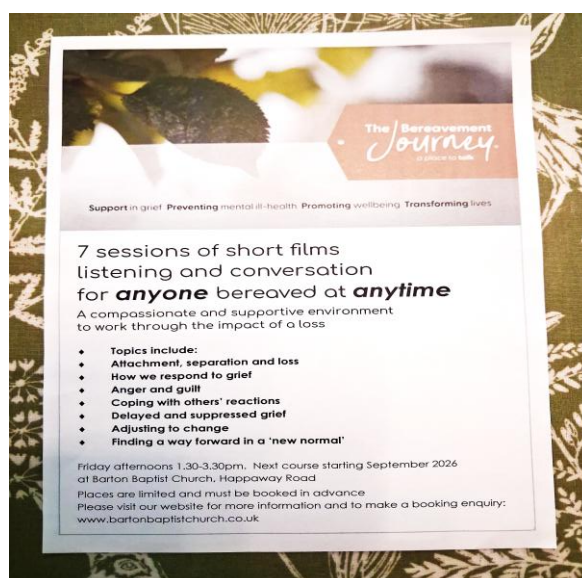
