CHURCH MATTERS

From Rose

I've been spending some time in Exodus recently and I'm always struck by the encounter between Moses and YHWH. God refers to Godself as I AM and reveals something of God's character to the ageing shepherd and ex-prince who we know as Moses.

But there is even more to know about Moses that we learn in Exodus 4. He describes himself as 'not a skilled speaker. I have never been able to speak well. And now, even after talking to you, I am not a good speaker. I speak slowly and can't find the best words'. Moses certainly doesn't think he is anything special.

But many theologians think that Moses is describing himself as disabled; possibly a speech impediment or maybe what we would now call a learning disability. We'll never know what Moses meant but we can be sure of God's response. God made Moses, and God did not make a mistake. God made Moses and wanted to use him, not in spite of his "flaws" but because of them. However weak, lacking in confidence or ability you may feel today, know that God loves what He made and has a use for you in God's great plan of justice and re-creation in God's kingdom. *ROSE*

3 weeks before Vision Day

Theme for the Week – Counting our Blessings

READ: Genesis 12: 1-5

The commissioning of Abram marks the start of God's plan to make himself known to all the nations on earth through a group of people, beginning with Abram and his family. God's covenant with Abram states that God will bless him and make him a blessing. It is in God's nature to bless us!

QUESTION: Over the last 5-10 yrs where have you seen God most at work through the mission and ministry of KCBC?

PRAY: As we look backwards over the last season of our church family's life, thank God for each of the instances where you have seen his hand of blessing. Thank God for his faithfulness to the church community over the years.

ACT: Record the examples of God's blessing you have recalled. Why not contact those who God has blessed you through this week to thank them – ask God who and how he wants to use you this week as a channel of his blessing...

A Word of Encouragement

ASK BIG! How about embracing this challenge: ask God for big things!

What do you desire to see in your life—in your family, health, finances, and career? What would you ask God for if you knew beyond the shadow of a doubt that He is good and that His love for you endures forever?

Ask God for them! Jesus came so that you might live a life that is marked not by lack, but by abundance; not by despair, but by the fullness of His love, joy, and peace.

Write down in your journal what you would ask God for if you knew that He hears your prayers. What are your dreams, hopes, and aspirations? What would we like to see come to pass in our life? What are you battling with today? Which area of your life would you like to see God’s power work in?

Write it down. Write it all down. Write what you want to see happen with Bible hope in your heart that He hears you and will supply. Write with a certain, joyful, positive, and confident expectation of good.

Don’t just ask God for small things. Ask Him for big things! For instance, don’t ask Him for just a job. Ask Him for a position of influence. Don’t just ask Him to restore your health. Ask Him for a long and healthy life filled with many good days.

Enlarge your faith to believe in God’s goodness. He is pleased when our faith is big. He is not offended when we ask Him for big things.

Would you do that right now? Just take a few moments and pen down your requests to God—God, who is almighty and more powerful than we can ever imagine. God, who hung the planets in their places and spoke order into the world. God, who led His people in a pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night. God, who rained manna from heaven and brought forth water from dry rock.

God, who turned bland waters into the finest wine. God, who made the lame walk, the blind see, and the deaf hear. God, who multiplied five loaves of bread and two small fish to feed five thousand men. God, who raised the dead and conquered the grave.

Ask what you need of God, who loves YOU
with an everlasting love!
