As Duty Deacon I would like to take the opportunity to highlight the work of the Pastoral Care Team here at KCBC for whom I have responsibility on behalf of the Leadership Team.

I have a team of people working with me. Mary Grubb, Steve Grubb, Paddy Smye and Jo Sweet. We have a WhatsApp group set up for easy communication with each other and we meet on a regular basis to review how we are doing and if we need to improve in any areas. We have a set of rules around safeguarding and confidentiality.

Our aim is to ensure that all those who are in need of pastoral care receive it. The way we do that is by chatting to people on a Sunday, noting those who are absent and follow up to make sure they are okay, or if somebody expresses a concern about a member of KCBC. We support by visiting those who are housebound. We regularly telephone those who are vulnerable. We telephone those who are unwell to establish if there is anything we can do to help. We will pray with those who ask and we always pray for those we care for.

If you would like further information on what we do, you think we could be doing more, or you are in need of pastoral care, then please don't hesitate to contact me, or one of the team. Thank you.

Ukraine prayer points

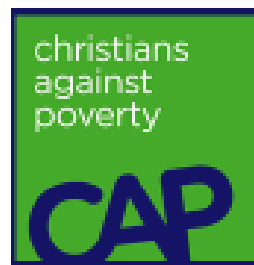
