So ... this week here is a report from Sue Furness for Eagles - Youth for Christ

Like Owls, we meet every Sunday morning during term time. YFC - Lumen is the programme we use for the teens within KCBC. It provides a structured series of themes that help them understand themselves while deepening their relationship with God. Each topic offers a variety of activities and levels of engagement — sometimes writing or drawing, other times racing around. It's generally noisy and fun for the kids, even at snack time, which is always the favourite part of the session.

It's wonderful to see our Eagles growing in confidence as they read and contemplate scripture, then share their understanding. They laugh a lot too. Honestly, they could run the group themselves — they are such a clever bunch.

If your child is in secondary school, they are the right age to join us. Our numbers vary. We have our superb regulars, of course but have just lost one of our "young adults" who deserves a special mention as they have

only just flown the nest for university. They are now getting her claws into some serious learning about horticulture, landscaping, and all things connected to the land.

We also have seasonal visitors, for example a couple of children from Poland — always welcome additions!

Eagles is run by a small group of leaders and helpers who would really appreciate some extra hands. You won't be required every week — just a couple of times per half term. Join us, and you'll enjoy developing warm relationships with our young people. They will make up names for you (in jest), reward you with a smile, and eat anything and everything you put in front of them.

Our hope and prayer is that the love of God remains in the hearts of our current Eagles as they soar and mature beyond the group, and that new families will join our church and help grow the Eagles programme.

Message from Hugh at cr2ee

"When Sarah asked how many lorries last year I said ten lorries last year, but alongside this we also give financial support every month. In 2025 alone, we were able to send more than £150,000 to Moldova and over £280,000 to Ukraine. These funds help sustain all our work, supporting refugees and families living in poverty. That's nearly £36,000 per month. Just to show every £1 counts.

As a completely voluntary charity, we are truly blessed by the generosity and faithfulness of our supporters. It is remarkable how, almost every month, we are able to fill a huge lorry to the roof. Time and again, our volunteers lovingly sort through mountains of donated clothing. A single bag may seem small, but together they become an abundant provision.


