Ram Fair

When Cheryl and I joined KCBC almost 20 years ago, we were impressed by the way that the church was a real part of the local community.

Having not been to the Kingsteignton Ram Fair before, it was a bit of an eye opener, thousands of people flocking through the gates of Oakford Lawn to enjoy a packed afternoon of fun, tradition and spectacle.



KCBC usually has the first or second plot from the entrance to the Lawn, meaning that everyone coming in immediately sees us, we take the opportunity to stop them in their tracks

with a fun stall, usually involving a physical activity or challenge, some thought-provoking questions or statements, and a craft activity for children or families, all on a relevant theme.

Since our first experience of the Ram Fair, we've always been keen to be involved as it shows to the whole local community that KCBC is open, approachable, and engaged in the life of Kingsteignton and the surrounding area.

Our team is on hand throughout the event to have conversations with members of the public, offering them insight into God's love and what it means to be in relationship with Him. We aim to be fun, friendly, and have a light-touch, not forcing ourselves or our message on people, but being available to engage with anyone who's open and shows interest.

In 2025 the theme was chosen as "Communication", we had 3 activities:

1) **The Track Game:** 2 people had to communicate well to work together, guiding a ball up a track full of twists and turns. Whilst designed to be a fun challenge, and in almost constant use, it proved to be even harder to complete than the slightly inaccurately named "Impossible Wire-Buzzer Challenge" from a few years ago.

2) **The Prayer Tree:** To encourage fair-goers to think about communication between themselves and God, the opportunity was given to write a prayer on a card and hang it on a tree within our marquee.

3) **Craft cards:** Our craft table is always very popular with families and children of all ages, this year we encouraged children to make a card with a message for their parent or another loved one.

Whilst the Ram Fair is very affordable for entry, most stalls charge for activities. We always choose to provide our stall and all activities within it for free, partly to lower the financial burden for a family day out, but also to demonstrate that God provides his salvation at no cost to us, the price being paid by Jesus himself.



In exchange for being given a free pitch, we also have the responsibility of running the Coconut Shy, for which there is a small charge, this goes directly to the Ram Fair

Committee, profits from the whole event are shared by all charities and organisations who participate, making us a beneficiary.

KCBC, being a community of enthusiastic and generous people, always manage to field a small team to plan the theme and activities, and a large team to set everything up, run all the activities and pack everything back down again.

We generally finish the day exhausted, and typically sunburnt and dehydrated, or wet and bedraggled, with a meal and debrief back at someone's house.

I'm sure that we all have many fun and meaningful memories of Ram Fairs over the years. One that will always stick in my mind is hearing over the tannoy, "The next round of the Tug-of-War competition is between the Hairy Bikers, and the Scrawny Baptists", well, it wasn't exactly that wording, but that was the reality of the two rather mis-matched teams. If you'd like to know who was victorious in this nail-biting conquest, Cheryl has video evidence!


The evening will include:

Message from Hugh at cr2ee

As we mark four years since the war in Ukraine began, we pause to reflect on the resilience, courage, and humanity that have defined this time. What began as an urgent response to unfolding tragedy has become a sustained commitment, a promise that we would stand alongside the people of Ukraine for as long as we are needed. Four years on, that promise remains unshaken.

Since those first days, articulated lorries filled with medical supplies and essential aid have made their long journeys eastward, carrying not only practical support but also a message: you are not forgotten. Alongside this, tens of thousands of pounds have been sent each month to help internal refugees, displaced families, and those facing poverty and uncertainty. Every box packed, every mile travelled, every pound given represents compassion in action.

None of this would be possible without the extraordinary generosity of our supporters here at home. To everyone who has donated, fundraised, given time, offered skills, or simply encouraged us along the way, we thank you. Your kindness has turned concern into practical help and hope.

We are equally grateful to our dedicated volunteers who faithfully sort, pack, organise, and load, often behind the scenes and without recognition. Your steady commitment, week after week, is the quiet engine that keeps this work moving forward.

Above all, we hold in deep admiration the people of Ukraine; those who continue to defend their homeland, and those who remain to care for families, neighbours, and communities under the most challenging circumstances. Their courage in the face of hardship, their determination to protect their freedom, and their refusal to lose hope inspire us daily.


