## From the Minister

As I write this, the new Roman Catholic pope is being chosen. The previous pope, Francis, has already had lots written about his papacy though it is not something many are too focussed on.

So to balance that, here is something we can focus on – his instructions to clergy. He said to leaders (in this case, priests) that they should be grounded in the situation of their flock. He said pastors should be "people capable of living, of laughing and crying with your people, in a word, of communicating with them". He told them, "Strip yourselves of your pre-constituted ideas, your dreams of greatness, your self-assertion, in order to put God and people at the centre of your daily concerns." He urged priests to be "shepherds with the 'smell of the sheep.""

What a helpful description of a good pastor. For that matter, a good deacon. And why not a good congregation. Alongside each other and those in our community. Not above, not removed but alongside. There's something of Christ in that.

#### How to join the Sunday Service via Zoom

- 1. Go onto the internet and type kcbchurch.org.uk
- 2. On the Home Page in the top right-hand corner is a green bar and on it is written "online service" with an arrow.
- 3. Click on the green bar/arrow and you'll go to the online services page.
- 4. On Sunday morning there will be a link title "Join Zoom Meeting" click the link and Zoom should open and connect you to the meeting.



#### **Sermon Recordings**
