Speaker's Corner

This week we welcome

*Rev Geoff Andrews to KCBC as
our Guest Speaker*

I moved from London to Devon in 2015 as interim minister at Brixham Baptist Church and retired in 2021. I was a minister for 40 years serving in churches in Sheffield and London before becoming Regional Minister Team Leader of the London Baptist Association. I am still involved in Brixham Baptist Church and am chaplain to Brixham RFC. I have recently completed a course of study to become a Spiritual Director. I play golf and enjoy my allotment and walking in this beautiful area.

From the Leadership

I am currently following a study entitled Facing Giants, and I felt it on my heart to share some of the message. Life has a way of placing giants in our path, they may not be towering warriors like Goliath, but they can be uncertainty, grief, illness, broken relationships, bullying, financial worries, concerns about the future. When we face these challenges, it is easy to feel overwhelmed. Yet throughout scripture, God reminds us that our hope is never found in our own strength, but in His faithfulness.

David faced Goliath with confidence because he knew the battle belonged to the Lord (1 Samuel 17:47). Joshua and Caleb looked at the same giants as everyone else, but they chose to trust God's promise rather than their fears (Numbers 14: 6-9). These stories remind us the size of our problem is never greater than the power of our God.

Whatever you are carrying this week, bring it to the Lord. Lift your eyes beyond the giant to the God who is greater.

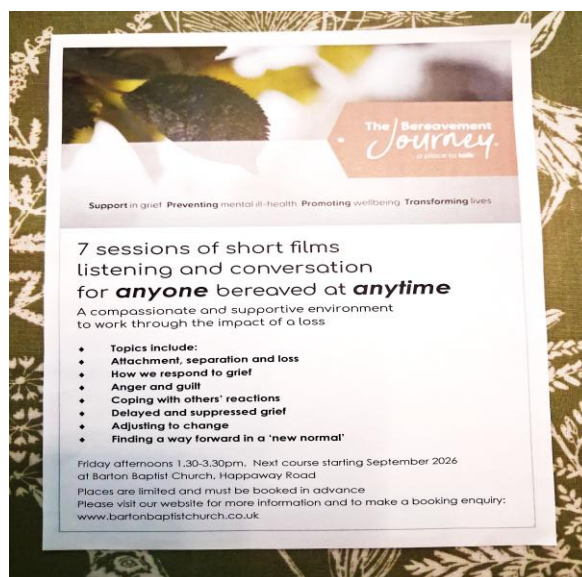

2. On the Home Page in the top right-hand corner is a green bar and on it is written "online service" with an arrow.
3. Click on the green bar/arrow and you'll go to the online services page.
4. On Sunday morning there will be a link title "Join Zoom Meeting" click the link and Zoom should open and connect you to the meeting.
