### *Zoom in the Sunday Service*

### *Update on the appointment of a Moderator*

The membership recently met to discuss and vote on a proposal from the leadership to call Rose Millard as our moderator.

The leadership made a presentation and there was a Q&A session followed by a vote. The members present voted to accept the proposal, and we will be calling Rose to be KCBC's moderator during the forthcoming pastoral vacancy period.

### *What the Spirit is Saying*

*This project has now been completed and thank you for all your input into the process. We have looked at all the raw data responses and identified the emerging themes for each of the four sections (Fellowship through belonging, Instruction in discipleship, Renewal in worship, Engagement with the world) and also identified some immediate priorities.*

*At this point we have decided to pause the process to concentrate on David's retirement. As we move into the pastoral vacancy period and we will pick up those themes and use them as we develop our Church profile and start the search for a new minister.*

*Our immediate priorities have been identified as follows*

- *Work to appoint a Moderator .. this has already been completed, and we welcome Rose Millard as our Moderator*
- *Agree how we are going to manage Pastoral Care*
- *Ensure all Sunday worship services are covered with a service leader and preacher*
- *Prepare for the October Church Members Meeting*
- *Set up teams to cover the necessary tasks (communion, catering, stewarding, etc.)*

*The future of KCBC requires us to start working together as a united fellowship and we will be discussing this further at the Church Members Meeting on 21 October.*

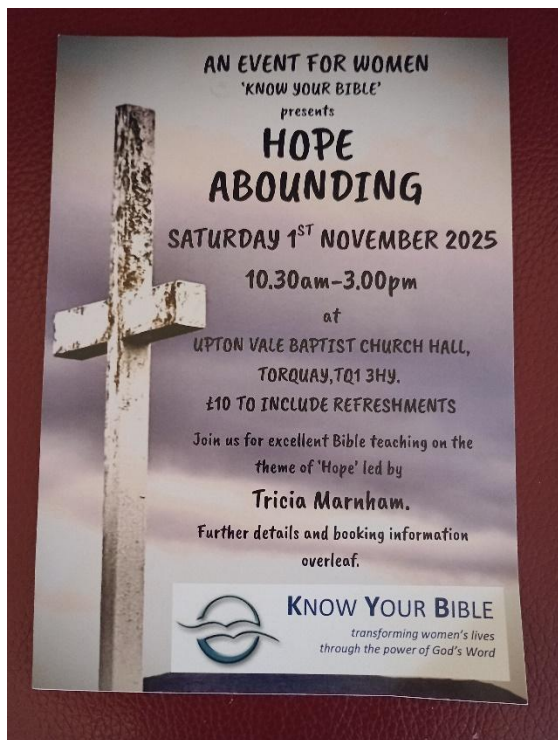

Christian Response to Eastern Europe

**Shoobox Appeal 2025**

If you would like to make up a shoobox this year, we need them at KCBC by Sunday 26th October.

Each shoobox should ideally contain:

- 1 pair of mittens or gloves;
- warm hat;
- scarf;
- notebook and pen/pencils/erasure/sharpener/colouring pencils;
- toothpaste and toothbrush;
- soap and face cloth;
- a 'doing' toy (skipping rope or ball);
- soft toy; and
- sweets/chocolate/biscuits.

Then it's up to you: but please ensure the box is well packed (to prevent movement on the journey and subsequent damage) a colouring book, a jumper or other clothing item and a ball can be added. The main difference between the adult & children box, is that for an adult you could include liquid soap

instead of a bar of soap, a comb or hairbrush, a sewing kit, hand cream, small packets of tissues and make-up or nail varnish (especially for teenage girls). You don't need to include a soft toy/doll.

Please do not add: jars of coffee, loose teabags or tins of food; drugs or plasters; packs of cards or reading material as most don't speak English.

All items should be new, in date by at least 6 months and age appropriate. Nothing within the shoebox should be wrapped, the box itself needs to be wrapped in a way that it can easily be opened to check the contents. Please put a sticker on the outside to specify the age and sex of the intended recipient. If you cannot do a full shoebox please send suitable items which can then be used to make up boxes. Thank you so much for all your support.

*Further Update*- Another lorry is being packed this Sunday afternoon (12/10) with your donations, which are going to Ukraine.

As always the Charity needs all hands to pack the lorry so, if you are free Sunday afternoon from 3pm for a couple of hours, your help would be much appreciated.

Also, there is now a special need for camp beds (anything that is collapsible and transportable) for field hospitals together with sleeping bags.

There is still so much happening in Moldova and Ukraine that needs our prayers and our thankfulness.
