## CHURCH MATTERS

### *Speakers' Corner!*

During my school years it was evident my talents in Art would guide my direction on leaving school. After completing the Sixth Form years I was employed by Morlands Sheepskin Manufacturing, a sister company to Clarks, and started three years at Strode College training to be a Shoemaker and gained a Business Studies degree as well as the Technology of Shoemaking and related products. I qualified as an Associate of the British Boot & Shoe Institute.

Following 38 years in the footwear trade in Clarks, Morlands, John Hulstik Design Savile Row, and Drapers I was made redundant at the end of 1998 due to the demise of Manufacturing in the UK.

Helen & I married in 1972, and almost immediately were involved with Christian Outreach Events linked to the Don Summers Evangelistic Association, The Arts Centre Group (ACG) & Christians in Entertainment (CIE). We are still involved with ACG

& CIE. In 1988 we became members of the Gideons International.

Having been involved in Church from an early age I applied for jobs within the Church Circles, and after some time seeking employment, I was offered the position of Chapel Manager at Westminster Chapel, a new position within the Church which I had to develop. I served alongside Dr R T Kendall until his retirement, and after spending a year working with the incoming minister Greg Haslam, I was offered the position of General Manager at Brunel Manor. This brought us to Torquay in 2003 where I spent seven years steering the ministry at Brunel before retiring in 2010.

We are still involved with Good News for Everyone (formerly Gideons) where I have served as a National Trustee and Regional Director since 2018. Our Partnership with ShareWord Global Canada gives us access to opportunities to be involved with the International Ministry worldwide.

- ▶ Many will come to Christ

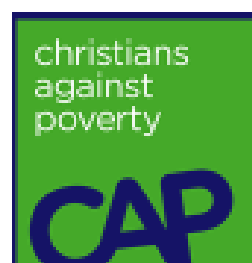

## Why do we go to church?

## How to join the Sunday Service via Zoom

1. Go onto the internet and type [kbcchurch.org.uk](http://kbcchurch.org.uk)
2. On the Home Page in the top right-hand corner is a green bar and on it is written "online service" with an arrow.
3. Click on the green bar/arrow and you'll go to the online services page.
4. On Sunday morning there will be a link title "Join Zoom Meeting" click the link and Zoom should open and connect you to the meeting.



## Sermon Recordings

The Sunday service is recorded but we only post the sermon on the website.

From the website homepage there is a link on the righthand side labelled "Recent Sermons" - this will take you to a page with all the recent sermons. The latest sermon is at the top, click either the audio only link or the video link.
