- ▶ Healing – physical, emotional and spiritual

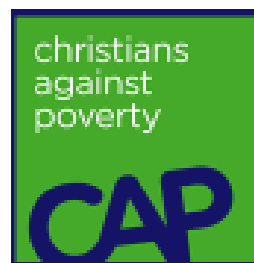
- ▶ A just peace
