Our recent Deacon's Away Day was a valuable time of quiet reflection, prayer, fellowship and honest soul-searching as we considered the future of the church during this pastoral vacancy. We were very kindly hosted by David and Tricia Butler to whom we extend our thanks and gratitude for a wonderful day in a beautiful location. We were also blessed with glorious weather and a superb meal.

The day was structured around four key areas: looking back with gratitude for God's faithfulness (Genesis 12:1-5), taking stock of

ourselves, taking stock of the church as we are today (Revelation 2&3), looking ahead to the future and considering the practical steps needed to move forward together (Jeremiah 29:10-14).

By the end of the day, we had developed a framework for the forthcoming Vision Day and had begun planning how to involve the whole church, both members and non-members, in discerning God's direction for us and how to write a church profile. The church profile will be divided into 7 subsections, and we have planned to make a start on 3 of those sections with the church fellowship. These sections are titled, The Church as it is Now, Our Surrounding Community, and The History of the Church. We are asking you to prayerfully consider what contributions you can make to one or more of these groups with your insights, experiences and knowledge. To help develop and write up each section, we are asking for 3 small groups to be created by using the sign-up sheets that will be produced shortly; each subsection will be overseen by a deacon.

Please join us in praying for unity, wisdom, and God's guidance as we continue this important process together. As a leadership team we look forward with excitement and anticipation to sharing this journey with the whole congregation as we work together to discern God's vision for the future of KCBC.

- ▶ Many will come to Christ

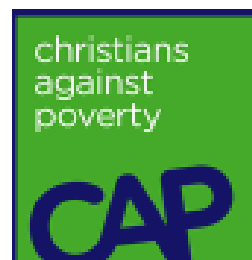

## How to join the Sunday Service via Zoom

1. Go onto the internet and type [kcbchurch.org.uk](https://www.kcbchurch.org.uk)
2. On the Home Page in the top right-hand corner is a green bar and on it is written "online service" with an arrow.
3. Click on the green bar/arrow and you'll go to the online services page.
4. On Sunday morning there will be a link title "Join Zoom Meeting" click the link and Zoom should open and connect you to the meeting.



## Sermon Recordings

The Sunday service is recorded but we only post the sermon on the website.

From the website homepage there is a link on the righthand side labelled "Recent Sermons" - this will take you to a page with all the recent sermons. The latest sermon is at the top, click either the audio only link or the video link.
