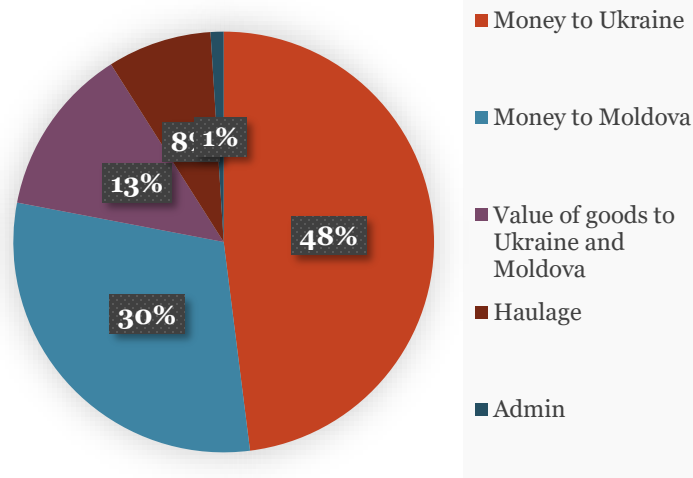
Christian Response to Eastern Europe

Looking back at 2025

During 2025, 9 trucks were sent to Ukraine and Moldova delivering 102 tonnes of humanitarian aid to people in desperate need. Thousands of families have been helped by this practical demonstration of God's love. This aid included generators and power packs which have helped homes and community groups in Ukraine to maintain a limited power supply during blackouts. Over 6000 shoe boxes were distributed across these two countries at Christmas which brought much joy and a sense of being remembered.

Due to your gifts, money is also sent to trusted partners in both countries, every month. Much care is taken to work with people who are known to us, with needs identified and explored before money is sent. This has enabled families to be fed, children to attend summer camps/Christmas celebrations, firewood to be bought to heat homes during the freezing winter months and much more. Thank you so much for your gifts and your prayers.

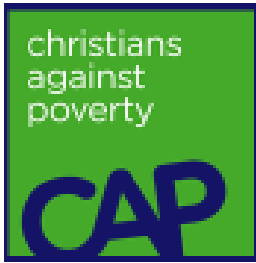
