### Christian Response to Eastern Europe

#### 2026 so far

Four aid trucks have been sent to Ukraine and Moldova. The most recent lorry arrived in Moldova while Hugh was there and it was really lovely to see clothes that had been sent from Exmouth being worn, and toys being played with. Hugh saw lots of happy faces and the people there know that someone cares. Thank you to all those who donate, those who sort and those who help load the lorries.

#### Moldova updates

- ▶ Furniture and stationery sent on a truck last year is being used in a kindergarden.
- ▶ A family we sponsor received seeds to grow, they have grown those into seedlings which we have now brought back and distributed to others to use.
- ▶ Hugh was in contact with lots of people that cr2ee have helped over the years.
- ▶ Helped to finance a new school room for children with disabilities in Borceag.

#### Moldova prayer points

- ▶ Good harvest for the seedlings.

- ▶ Dima (son of the late Pastor Boris) in Chiperceni, has a new vision and is in the process of building a sports field for the children, with financial help from cr2ee.
- ▶ Marianna, who has been helping cr2ee for 20 years, Hugh is helping her with visas so that she can hopefully visit the UK with her children this summer.
- ▶ Tanya, a young child who desperately needs surgery on her feet for her development. Specifically that her mother, Natasha, can raise the finance for the operation.

#### Ukraine updates

- ▶ Hugh reports from his recent visit a shocking increase in the number of Russian drone attacks.
- ▶ Children have very gratefully received toys that have been sent on the lorries.
- ▶ An injured soldier, Vola, is teaching his 2 children to speak English and was pleased to receive some children's English books.
- ▶ The boards that we load on to the lorry to secure the donations are themselves being used to make items of furniture.

#### Ukraine prayer points

- ▶ Pastor Andrii who acts as a distribution point for the humanitarian aid that is sent to Ukraine as well as caring for a network of churches and working with military chaplains.

- ▶ For all pastors serving churches and the many displaced and traumatized people.
- ▶ Widows, orphans, the seriously injured and those struggling with fears for loved ones and the future.
- ▶ Healing – physical, emotional and spiritual.
- ▶ Pray for Hleb, a young boy who has cancer, pray for his treatment.
- ▶ Anja who had a traumatic childhood and is now studying to be a doctor.
- ▶ Pray for information about missing soldiers.
- ▶ Returned prisoners, and their families, adjusting to life back in Ukraine.
- ▶ Give thanks for all the joy given in the receipt of toys, clothes and other donations.
- ▶ Pray for a lasting peace.
