### Christian Response to Eastern Europe Update and Prayer

requests January 2026

#### UKRAINE

As you will have seen on the news, the situation in Ukraine is grave. Russia continues to target the civilian population and energy infrastructure and the supply of interceptor missiles by its allies has reduced. Recently, temperatures have also plummeted to -17 at night and -12 in the day. Long power-cuts are an every-day occurrence.

Against this backdrop the work of cr2ee continues and we are making a real difference. Just one of our partner churches is supporting 60-70 families with food parcels. So far, they have provided 1440 parcels which represents over 7 tonnes of food aid. For pensioners, over half their income can be spent on medicines and medical help leaving little for food and heating so this support is life changing.

cr2ee is also supporting vulnerable, internally displaced people and military families. Here is just one example. David is still very young, yet life asked more of him than it ever should. When his sister passed away, she left behind three children who suddenly had no mother. Without hesitation, David stepped forward and opened his heart and home to them; two boys aged 16 and 13, and a little girl aged just 9. They lived together in a small flat. Life was hard, money was scarce, but what they had was love, determination, and each other. Despite their grief and struggles, they were a close, caring family who were doing their very best to move forward after an unimaginable loss.

On 9 January, everything changed again. The block of flats they lived in was struck by a Russian missile. By the grace of God, none of the family were seriously injured, but their home was gone. This is not an isolated story. This is the heartbreaking reality for so many families across Ukraine right now - families who have already endured so much, now forced to start again with nothing. Because of the incredible kindness and generosity of cr2ee supporters, we are able to stand



alongside David and the children and help them through this devastating time.

Much support is being provided to members of the military and their families. Camp beds, tourniquets, medical supplies, clothing and emotional support is making a real difference. Many injured soldiers reach field hospitals in the fatigues they were wearing which often need to be cut away for them to be treated. There were 8 pallets of new clothing, donated by local businesses, on the last Aid Lorry but there is still a need for simple things like new underwear and socks for these service personnel.

Those recovering or coming home on leave are finding it hard to adjust after all that they have seen and endured on the front line. This is not only hard for them but also for their families.

Please pray for

- ▶ An end to the war and lasting, just peace.
- ▶ Much of the power grid has been damaged with power rationed across the country but generators and power packs as well as gas and spare parts for stoves provided through your donations are helping.

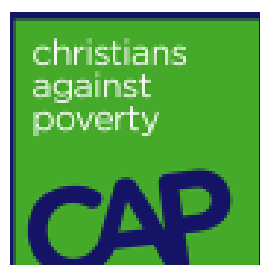
- ▶ David and his nephews and niece and other families suffering grief and displacement.
- ▶ The service personnel and their families as they spend a short amount of time together and try and cope with all that they have endured.
- ▶ The work cr2ee is doing with our partner churches to support the wives and mothers of the missing. Please pray for all those attending.
- ▶ The "soup kitchens" and the distribution of food parcels to those who are really struggling.
- ▶ We give thanks for the medical supplies that have been donated to be used at the front field hospitals.
- ▶ Please pray for wisdom for the trustees of cr2ee, that they can discern where help is needed the most, that the work is able to continue and that any obstacles be removed.



BUT most of all please pray for peace and that God's love will shine through all cr2ee is doing in Ukraine.

## How to join the Sunday Service via Zoom

1. Go onto the internet and type [kcbchurch.org.uk](http://kcbchurch.org.uk)
2. On the Home Page in the top right-hand corner is a green bar and on it is written "online service" with an arrow.
3. Click on the green bar/arrow and you'll go to the online services page.
4. On Sunday morning there will be a link title "Join Zoom Meeting" click the link and Zoom should open and connect you to the meeting.



## Sermon Recordings

The Sunday service is recorded but we only post the sermon on the website.

From the website homepage there is a link on the righthand side labelled "Recent Sermons" - this will take you to a page with all the recent sermons. The latest sermon is at the top, click either the audio only link or the video link.
