I visited Portsmouth for a couple of days last week and, during my stay, my host took me to see a statue of Isambard Kingdom Brunel, one of Britain's greatest engineers, who was born there in 1806. Brunel spent his life building bridges, tunnels and railways that connected communities, and opened up new possibilities and new horizons. Westminster Abbey honours him with a stained-glass window showing biblical scenes of building the Temple and Christ's teaching, which is a reminder that human creativity and perseverance reflect something of God's creative work of shaping, guiding and building. As Brunel built pathways across the nation, may we be people who build pathways of hope, faith and connection at KCBC and in our local communities. **David B**

I was born and brought up on a dairy and sheep farm in Mid Devon. My parents were Christians and I went to our local chapel with them. I realised just because my parents were Christians didn't make me one, nor would going to church. I had to make that choice for myself and aged 8, I did just that. At 13, I started singing in a group called *Good News* with my brother and friends and we went to churches all over the South West sharing the story of God's love.

We even sang at a flower show and on a beach!! I was 14 when our pastor (who had a huge impact on my life) asked if I would help him in a service by giving out a song and doing the Bible reading. In time it went on to praying, then my testimony and eventually the message. I believe God called me, from a very young age, to tell people about His love for them which is why I'm here this morning.
