#### 2026 so far

Two aid trucks have already been sent to Ukraine, and one was sent to Moldova last week. Hugh Scudder travelled to Moldova on 23 March and will then travel on to Ukraine.

Please pray:

- ▶ For his safekeeping during his visit and for his wife while he is away
- ▶ For wisdom and discernment as he meets partners and individuals
- ▶ That God will show him how we can best support these dear people
- ▶ That he might be an encouragement to all those he meets

#### Moldova prayer points

- ▶ Safe arrival and the distribution of the aid on the latest truck
- ▶ Dima (son of the late Pastor Boris) in Chiperceni, working with children providing activities and sharing Jesus as well as running a soup kitchen
- ▶ Pastor Vasile in Borceag who is helping those in extreme poverty, running summer camps alongside pastoring a church
- ▶ The many vulnerable families struggling with disability, ill health or absent parents

#### Ukraine prayer points

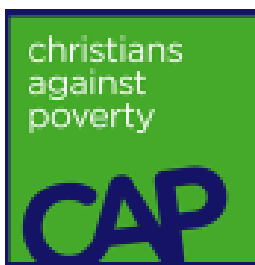

2. On the Home Page in the top right-hand corner is a green bar and on it is written "online service" with an arrow.
