- ▶ Healing – physical, emotional and spiritual

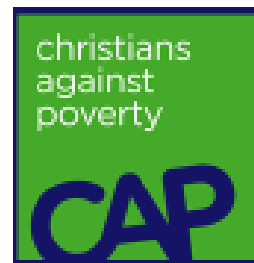
- ▶ A just peace

## A Word of Encouragement

We very much enjoy ocean cruising, and part of the experience is talking to the crew and fellow passengers. A few weeks ago we started a friendship with a young lady working in one of the on board boutiques. She told us that she is from Ukraine. We felt the Holy Spirit moving us to want to spend some time talking to her during the cruise. We learnt that her family has had to move to Odessa, as their hometown is too close to the front line. Even there, the population has to be prepared to move at one hour's notice should there be an imminent attack.

We felt we should encourage her by reassuring her that the UK will always stand with Ukraine, and that we believe that good will always triumph over evil. We talked with her about the reassurances found in God's word, for example in Psalm 91. As a small treat we arranged for her one evening to dine with us in one of the ship's fine dining restaurants. This is something that is not normally allowed as the crew have their own mess, but she was so grateful. We promised to keep in touch.

This was an unexpected opportunity for us to encourage someone who is clearly facing the evil one. Opportunities like that can come at any time, and we should seize them. As the Holy Spirit, speaking through Paul, says in 1 Thessalonians 5:11 - "Encourage one another and build each other up!"
