Christian Response to Eastern Europe

Update and Prayer requests July 2025

Since it started nearly 30 years ago 120 articulated lorries full of humanitarian aid have gone to Eastern Europe. The next one is due to go to Ukraine in August; this would not be possible without your ongoing support. THANK YOU

Through the generosity of cash donations, we are able to support soup kitchens and summer camps for children in both Moldova and Ukraine. THANK YOU

UKRAINE

On Monday evening Pastor Andrii joined our zoom call, he is the Baptist Union area lead and the one who distributes the aid once it arrives in Ukraine. He thanked everyone for their prayer and other support saying that "*The support means more than we can ever know*".

He asked that we pray for:

- ▶ An end to the war and lasting peace.
- ▶ The future of churches in his area, Ukraine is running out of men to fight, and they are now drafting pastors from churches that have already lost their support workers to the army. There is a concern as to how the work the churches are doing to support their local people will be able to continue, and for the safety of these men.

- ▶ The widows and orphans, injured soldiers and those whose family members are missing.
- ▶ We give thanks for the summer camps (both for children and for wives of the soldiers) and for the comfort spiritually, as well as physically, that they bring.

The last lorry to Ukraine had 70 bikes (if you have one you would like to donate please talk to Sarah or Nick) 15 pallets of toys (donated by a local company), school equipment as well as the usual aid clothes, pots and pans and medical equipment.

CR2EE has now set up and continues to support 15 "soup kitchens" in Ukraine.

MOLDOVA

Life is still very difficult in Moldova especially in the villages where there is little work and NO state support for the vulnerable. A young lady Lydia (just turned 18) now works to support her three brothers, their mother is dead and father drinks, she is the only bread winner, but CR2EE is now finding ways to help.

We give thanks that we were able to find funding for the warehouse to be repaired so work can continue in Moldova.

We give thanks that once again we were able to sponsor children to go to summer camps where they receive good food, teaching and enjoy playing (just being children).

There is a huge need in Moldova, but we are making a massive difference to individuals, families and communities, we change lives, but this is only possible due to the support both material and prayers of people in the UK so THANK YOU.

Somewhat of a heads' up and certainly plenty of notice CR2EE will be going ahead with Christmas Shoe Boxes once again this year. Further information will be forthcoming on what can go into the boxes and timings etc, after the Summer.

There is much more happening in Moldova and Ukraine that needs our prayers and our thankfulness.
